



MODIFIED FAST 4 RULES & SUMMARY

A set is first to 4 games, win by 1. At 3 games all (3-3), a 5-point tiebreaker is played to win the set 4-3. (It's like being 6-6 in a set and playing a tiebreaker to win 7-6.)

The match is still best 2 out of 3 sets. If the sets are split 1-1, then a 5-point tiebreaker is played to win the 3rd set/match. All tiebreakers are 5 points and win by 1.

SCORING (no ad)

- Scoring will remain: 15, 30, 40, game.
- At deuce (40-40), the winner of the next point wins the game.

SERVICE LETS (no change from regular rules)

- If the ball hits the net and lands in the service box on first serve, the first serve is repeated.
- If the ball hits the net and lands in the service box on the second serve, the second serve is repeated.

FAST 4 TIEBREAKER @ 3 GAMES ALL OR SPLIT SETS (all tiebreakers are 5 points & win by 1)

- Starting on the deuce side, the first player serves 2 points.
- Starting on the deuce side, the second player serves 2 points.
- Players will change ends after 4 points have been played.

Example:

Singles

Player A-2 points serving

Player B-2 points serving

Change ends

Doubles

Player A (or Player C)-2 points serving

Player B (or Player D)-2 points serving

Change ends

- If a tiebreaker reaches 4-4 in singles or doubles, players come to the net and spin the racquet to determine serve or side preference (same as spinning a racquet prior to the start of a match). The next point wins.
